

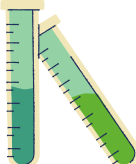

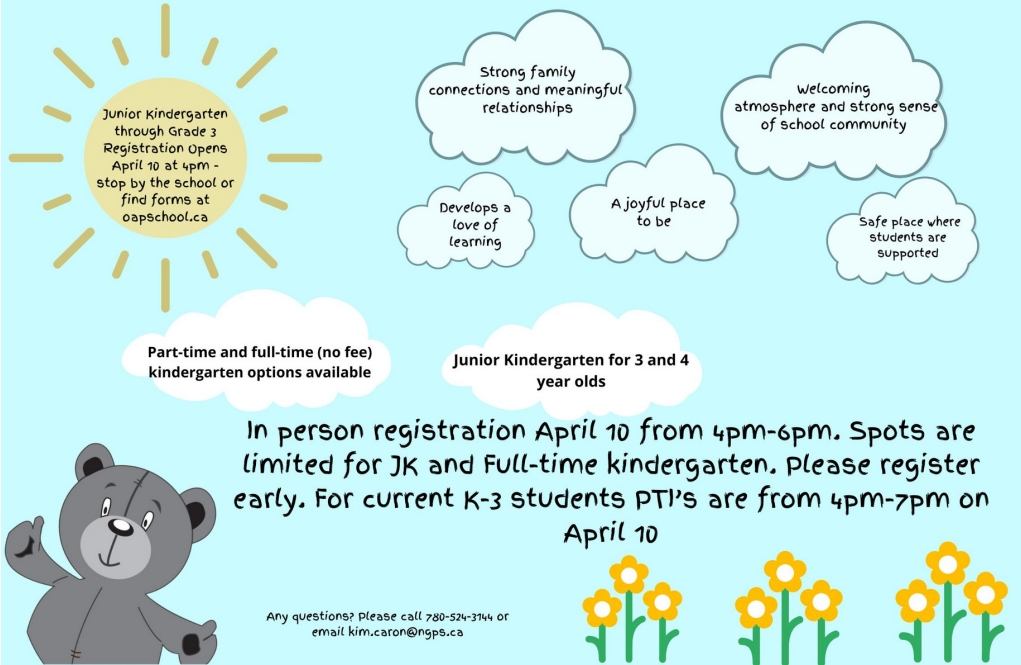

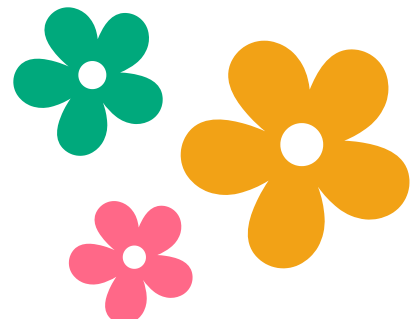

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This April we continue focusing on Learning Through Play!

- Looking for ways to play at home? Try this homemade Play-Doh recipe! Don't forget to seal it in an airtight container and it will last for weeks.
 - measure $\frac{3}{4}$ of a cup of water and then remove 3 tablespoons of water (to make room for lemon juice)
 - add 3 tablespoons of lemon juice to the water
 - heat in the microwave until just boiling (about 2 minutes)
 - in a separate bowl combine 1 cup flour and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup salt
 - add food colouring to your water/lemon mixture once it is hot
 - slowly add the liquid to the flour mixture and stir until it becomes a dough
 - add 1 tablespoon of cooking oil and knead the dough with your hands
 - if dough is too dry try adding a little more oil
 - once dough is cool it is ready for playing

A combination of motor, sensory, communication, and cognitive skills used to learn, play, and socialize



Begin developing as a newborn



Applied when we learn information and use it to complete a task

When do we use executive function skills?

What are some of the tasks executive function helps with?



Completing homework and chores



Finishing a project



Playing with friends and having control over emotions



Asking for help and alerting others when needed



Getting to work and school on time

What are some ways you can help?



Have predictable routines



Bring children with on errands



Let them have unstructured playtime
