

1. **Matching Game:** Turn over cards and find pairs with the same pictures.
2. **Number Learning:** Look at cards with numbers and learn what they look like.
3. **Counting Fun:** Count how many things are on the cards or how many cards you have.
4. **Sorting Cards:** Sort cards by color, number, or picture.
5. **Math Games:** Play adding or subtracting games with the numbers on the cards.
6. **Memory Game:** Try to remember where the matching cards are when you turn them over.
7. **Making Patterns:** Put cards in order from smallest to biggest numbers or make patterns with colors.
8. **Story Time:** Make up stories about the pictures on the cards.
9. **Playing Together:** Play card games with friends or family to practice sharing and taking turns.

Card Game ideas:

1. **Go Fish:** Ask others for cards you need to make sets of four. If they don't have the card, you draw from the deck.
2. **War:** Compare cards with others, and the one with the highest card wins both.
3. **Crazy Eights:** Match cards with the top one in the pile, or draw until you can.
4. **Snap:** Shout "Snap!" when you see two matching cards in a row. Win the pile.
5. **Go Boom:** Match cards with the top one in the pile, or draw until you can. First to get rid of all cards wins.
6. **Spit:** Race to play your cards onto the center piles. Match cards in order.
7. **Old Maid:** Get rid of pairs. The one left with the "Old Maid" card loses.
